Garbage Cans Regulations –

The city of Eau Claire has very clear guidelines for garbage cans. They must be stored behind dwelling setbacks, not in the yard. Lids on garbage containers must be kept closed. Only licensed refuse haulers can be placed at curbside. If you have a container that fit instead these containers can be placed curbside.

Containers can not be placed curbside earlier than 5:00am and must be removed from the curb the same day of placement.

Recyclables at curbside must be in a recycling bin and not scattered.

Yard Main

Our covenants specify that lawns and yards in condition must be in a “park like” condition so that all homeowners must also specify that lawn growth can not exceed 6” in height.

Dog Iss

Pet owners are reminded that all dogs and cats in the city of Eau Claire has very specific rules about pet owners. Fines of \$198 for each violation! A fenced in “dog park” behind Kohls for exercising your dog.
